

<b>Common Name</b>	<b>Common Tree Senna</b>
<b>Botanical Name</b>	<i>Cassia corymbosa</i>
<b>Other Names</b>	Argentine Senna, Yellow Senna, Flowering Senna
<b>Description</b>	Ornamental with bright yellow flowers from spring to frost. Drought tolerant, suitable for xeriscaping, does not tolerate wet conditions. Can be shrub-like or trained into small tree.
<b>Plant Type</b>	Shrub or Tree
<b>Plant Size</b>	6 – 8' tall x 4 – 6' wide
<b>Light Requirements</b>	Sun, Part Sun
<b>Water Requirements</b>	Medium
<b>Soil Requirements</b>	Well drained soil, including caliche
<b>Evergreen or Deciduous</b>	Semi-evergreen
<b>Native Status</b>	Adapted, Origin South America
<b>Pollinators</b>	Butterflies, hummingbirds
<b>Care Notes</b>	Tolerates intense heat and sun. Reseeds prolifically. Susceptible to extreme cold; may need to be cut back by half if freeze damaged.
