Other Names	Dwarf Mexican Petunia, Mexican Petunia, Katie's Ruellia
Description	Dwarf perennial that produces bluish purple trumpet shaped flowers. Has dark green glossy foliage from spring to frost. Compact low mounding plant.
Plant Type	Perennial
Plant Size	6 - 12" tall x 8 - 12" wide
Light Requirements	Full sun, Mostly sunny, Part shade, Part sun
Water Requirements	During droughts, some irrigation may be needed.
Soil Requirements	No special requirement, but in good soil it grows well
Evergreen or Deciduous	Evergreen
Native Status	Native to Mexico
Pollinators	Butterflies, Bees
Care Notes	Shade tolerant, but flowers best when grown in sunny areas. This durable perennial makes a great border, groundcover, or makes a great addition to containers.
