Botanical Name	<i>Lantana camara</i> 'Dallas Red'

Description	Compact, spreading woody shrub with dark green, rough textured foliage. Blooms clusters of orange, red, yellow flowers from spring to frost.
Plant Type	Perennial
Plant Size	2 - 3' tall and 3 - 4' wide
Light Requirements	Full sun to part shade
Water Requirements	Low to moderate
Soil Requirements	Prefers well drained
Evergreen or Deciduous	Deciduous
Native Status	Adapted
Pollinators	Butterflies, bees and birds
Care Notes	Fruit (dark berries) and plants are toxic to humans and animals. Can be cut back in late winter/early spring. Prune to shape or to rejuvenate during growing season.
