Other Names	Trailing or weeping lavender lantana
Description	Prolific blooming with a wealth of purple flowers spring to frost. A very adaptable and popular perennial, which can be used as a ground cover.
Plant Type	Perennial
Plant Size	1.5 - 2' tall x 4+' wide
Light Requirements	Full sun to part shade
Water Requirements	Low.
Soil Requirements	Any
Evergreen or Deciduous	Semi-evergreen
Native Status	Adapted
Pollinators	Butterflies, bees and birds
Care Notes	Fruit (dark berries) and plants are toxic to humans and animals. Can be cut back in late winter/early spring. Prune to shape or to rejuvenate during growing season.
