

<b>Common Name</b>	<b>Muhly, Gulf Coast</b>
<b>Botanical Name</b>	<i>Muhlenbergia capillaris</i>
<b>Other Names</b>	Hair-awn Muhly, Hairy-awn Muhly, Hair Grass, Pink Muhly
<b>Description</b>	Grass with an airy, multi-branched seed head. Blooms look like a purple haze in the fall. Good general garden plant.
<b>Plant Type</b>	Perennial
<b>Plant Size</b>	2.5' tall x 2 - 3' wide
<b>Light Requirements</b>	Full sun, part shade
<b>Water Requirements</b>	Low to Medium
<b>Soil Requirements</b>	Native soil type: Sandy, sandy loam, clay, rocky.
<b>Evergreen or Deciduous</b>	Deciduous
<b>Native Status</b>	TX Native
<b>Pollinators</b>	None
<b>Care Notes</b>	Trim dead foliage back within a few inches of the ground in late winter before new growth begins to emerge in spring.
