Description	A large-bodied, upright plant for the back of landscape beds or large containers. Large purple blooms stand out against black stems from Spring, through Summer and Fall. This is a more-compact, patented hybrid of Majestic Sage.
Plant Type	Perennial
Plant Size	40-48" (h) x 36-48" (w)
Light Requirements	Full sun to mostly sun. Heat tolerant.
Water Requirements	Medium.
Soil Requirements	Tolerates many well-drained soils.
Evergreen or Deciduous	Deciduous. Usually freezes to the ground in winter. Mulch at the base of the plant in late fall will help protect the root system. Container grown plants may need winter protection.
Native Status	No
Pollinators	Hummers, bees & butterflies
Care Notes	A light shearing in midsummer will promote new growth and flowers. Midsummer fertilizer helps produce more blooms. It may spread underground by rhizomes.
