Description	Cut-leaf silvery gray foliage is a nice contrast to blue-lavender flowers. Great choice for Xeriscaping. Leaves are aromatic. Blooms in late summer to fall.

Soil Requirements	Most soils, if well drained.

Care Notes	Low Maintenance. Drought tolerant shrub. Prune near ground in late winter/early spring. Although it is an herb, the leaves are toxic if ingested.
