

Common Name	Salvia, Indigo Spires
Botanical Name	<i>Salvia longispicata x farinacea</i>
Other Names	Sage, Indigo spires sage
Description	Masses of long, twisted spikes of indigo blue flowers. Blooms continuously from early summer to frost.
Plant Type	Perennial
Plant Size	2 - 3' high x 2 - 3' wide
Light Requirements	Full sun or light shade
Water Requirements	Medium
Soil Requirements	Well drained chalk, loam sand.
Evergreen or Deciduous	Evergreen, semi-evergreen
Native Status	Adaptive
Pollinators	Butterflies, hummingbirds, bees
Care Notes	Water and fertilize regularly to keep it flowering. Pinch stems early in the growing season and deadhead the faded flower spikes to promote more blooms. Can be trimmed to maintain shape.
