

<b>Common Name</b>	<b>Salvia, Mystic Spires</b>
<b>Botanical Name</b>	<i>Salvia longispicata x farinacea Lab-Modified</i>
<b>Other Names</b>	Mystic Spires, Blue Salvia
<b>Description</b>	Grows many stalks of true blue flowers from Spring to frost; this improved variety sheds dead petals
<b>Plant Type</b>	Perennial
<b>Plant Size</b>	18 - 24" tall x 12 -18" wide
<b>Light Requirements</b>	Full sun
<b>Water Requirements</b>	Low
<b>Soil Requirements</b>	Needs good drainage in most soils
<b>Evergreen or Deciduous</b>	Deciduous (will drop leaves after frost in our area)
<b>Native Status</b>	Adapted
<b>Pollinators</b>	Hummingbirds, bees and butterflies
<b>Care Notes</b>	May be pruned during growing season, then down to 12' in fall & to the ground only when growth is strong in Spring
<b>Texas Superstar</b>	Yes
