Botanical Name	<i>Salvia longispicata x farinacea Lab-Modified</i>
Other Names	Mystic Spires, Blue Salvia
Description	Grows many stalks of true blue flowers from Spring to frost; this improved variety sheds dead petals
Plant Type	Perennial
Plant Size	18 - 24" tall x 12 -18" wide
Light Requirements	Full sun
Water Requirements	Low
Soil Requirements	Needs good drainage in most soils
Evergreen or Deciduous	Deciduous (will drop leaves after frost in our area)
Native Status	Adapted
Pollinators	Hummingbirds, bees and butterflies
Care Notes	May be pruned during growing season, then down to 12' in fall & to the ground only when growth is strong in Spring
