

Common Name	Salvia, Nuevo Leon
Botanical Name	<i>Salvia greggii x lycioides</i>
Other Names	Nuevo Leon Autumn Sage
Description	Stalks of dark purple and purple flowers emerge from striking stems amidst green foliage. Summer to Late Fall. Fast growing.
Plant Type	Perennial
Plant Size	2' tall x 2' wide
Light Requirements	Full sun to part shade
Water Requirements	Low water tolerant. Drought tolerant once established
Soil Requirements	Well drained sandy loam.
Evergreen or Deciduous	Evergreen in warm winter areas
Native Status	Adapted
Pollinators	Butterflies, hummingbirds, bees
Care Notes	Requires very little attention. Cut back by 1/3 after first flowering to keep compact. Remove spent flower spikes to promote further blooms. Prune to the ground in late winter.
